<b>VISION DOCUMENT</b>		
1	<b>Vision</b>	The vision of the Department is to ensure 24x7 air connectivity to Goa from all over the globe and become an economic driver for the State.
2.	<b>Objective</b>	The Department of Civil Aviation was created in the year 2014 for development of Greenfield International Airport at Mopa in Pernem taluka in particular and aviation sector in general. The Department has successfully completed the bid process for Mopa Airport in the year 2016 and Concession Agreement has being signed with GGIAL on 8 <sup>th</sup> November 2016. Presently, the airport construction work is in progress.
3.	<b>Short term goal</b>	The Phase I of the Mopa Airport is expected to be commissioned in August 2022. In addition, it is also proposed to complete land acquisition for Mopa Airport expressway and begin construction work through PWD.
4.	<b>Medium term goal</b>	The Phase I of the Mopa Airport is proposed to be commissioned August 2022. It is also proposed to complete and commission the Mopa Airport expressway connecting NH66 to the Mopa Airport in the year 2022.
5.	<b>Long term goal</b>	The Mopa Airport is being constructed in 4 phases. The design capacity of phase I is 4.4 million passengers per annum (mppa) followed by 5.8 mppa, 9.4 mppa and 13.1 mppa in phase II, phase III and phase IV respectively. The project has ultimate potential of over

		30 mppa. Phase wise development is traffic triggered, upon achievements of 80% of the target of preceding phase.
6.	<b>Strategic Planning</b>	In order to resolve various issues in construction of the airport the Department has a project monitoring committee under Chief Secretary. The committee has been meeting at regular intervals and resolving the issues in time bound manner. Further, the project is also being monitored on priority basis by the Hon'ble Chief Minister at regular intervals. In addition the project is now included under Goa Pragati Portal for monitoring by Hon'ble Chief Minister. The project is also included under PRAGATI portal of Government of India for review by Hon'ble Prime Minister
7.	<b>Action Plan</b>	The Department has also established Mopa Airport Development Authority (MADA) to provide better commutation facilities to the residents of Goa, tourists visiting Goa from within India and overseas, and to provide a for a state of the art Airport and other infrastructure facilities and; in order to secure the welfare of the villagers adjoining Mopa Airport, for their orderly development and in order to give benefits of Mopa Airport to these villagers and for securing the orderly establishment of the Mopa Greenfield International Airport and for that matter to provide for speedy issuance of various licenses, clearances and certificates required for setting up of the Mopa Greenfield International Airport, infrastructural facilities, developmental work and upgradation of

		existing infrastructural facilities connected with or relating to Mopa Greenfield International Airport project and for purposes connected therewith and incidental thereto.
